




<p>Are you curious about what it's like to live on a tropical island? Students will discover pirate life as well as the life of different island creatures. During the week, children will explore food chains; sinking and floating; create wonderful island inspired art using various materials; read related fiction and non-fiction books; and concoct delicious food for snacks. We'll also have some "survivor" type challenges and experiment with island music. At the end of the week, students will be ready to set sail for a tropical island!</p>	<p>In this class, students will explore science, math, reading, and art using cookies, pancakes, muffins, as well as mice, pigs, and moose. Each day will highlight a different Laura Numeroff book through a variety of hands on experiences. If you take this class, you'll want to take another one.</p> 	<p>Each day, children will participate in hands on activities to discover a variety of tales. They will experiment with a variety of building materials; become "Pigasso" while creating related art (<i>The Three Little Pigs</i>); concoct "beary" interesting snacks (<i>Goldilocks and the Three Bears</i>); distinguish between fact and fiction related to animals portrayed in the stories; and use drama and movement to create a unique version of a tale.</p>

During the week, participants will become archeologists to explore inventions, customs, food, and other aspects that make Egypt so intriguing. Throughout the week, students will learn vocabulary, experiment with embalming, and create unique Egyptian art and food. Hopefully, we will avoid the curse of the mummy!</p> 	<p>In this class, student detectives will conduct many hands-on forensic science tests on evidence found at "crime scenes" in order to solve them. Throughout the week, detectives will explore chromatography; pH of a substance; fingerprints; smell; and a variety of other techniques to determine the solution to the mysteries. At the end of this class, the student detectives will be able to match wits with the great Sherlock Holmes.</p>	<p>The staff at Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry is opening the door to all interested Muggles, especially those with a penchant for wizardry. During the week, students will explore herbology; potions; spells and charms; astronomy; arithmancy; and Care of Magical Creatures. Muggles may even be called upon to defend Hogwarts from the Dark Arts; so be prepared for an adventure! <i>Draco Dormiens Nunquam Titillandus</i></p>
